Because of the unprecedented interest in the newest Smithsonian museum, access for the next several months will be provided by free timed passes which are available here <https://nmaahc.si.edu/visit/passes>.

Advanced Timed Passes for April 2017 have been made available.

Reserve your free Advanced Timed Pass online (link above) or by calling 866-297-4020.

Same-day, online Timed Passes can be reserved at 6:30am daily on the museum website:

If you are not able to secure advance time passes, 'same-day' tickets will be given out on a first-come, first-served basis. There is no guarantee for these tickets, but it's worth exploring if you're already planning to be in Washington for other events or meetings.

Same Day In-person Four (4) free Timed Passes per visitor can be obtained in person, at the Museum on the same day of your visit or through the link above. Passes are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis.

Nonprofit Groups School, student, religious and community-based organizations with groups of 10 or more may obtain free Advance Timed Passes. It is recommended groups provide at least one adult chaperone for every five (5) students under the age of 18.
