I am requesting funding for the Adult & Child Health Facility Renovation in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is Adult & Child Health, located at 234 E. Southern Ave, Indianapolis, IN 46237.

The funding would be used for the renovation of an existing health facility, including critical roof replacement, interior construction to expand clinical capacity, and the purchase of capital equipment. The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it expands integrated primary care and crisis stabilization services for over 4,000 low-income residents, reducing the local burden on emergency departments and improving health outcomes in an underserved area.
