I am requesting funding in the amount of \$6,430,000 to the City of Indianapolis Department of Public Utilities for Dig Indy/Combined Sewer Overflow project in fiscal year 2023.

The entity to receive funding for this project is City of Indianapolis Departemnt of Public Utilities (D/B/A Citizens Energy Group) located at 2020 North Meridian Street Indianapolis, Indiana 46202.
