I am requesting funding in the amount of \$1,000,203 for Workforce Inc. (DBA Recycleforce)
From Prisoner to Citizen Project in fiscal year 2023.

The entity to receive funding for this project is Workforce Inc. (DBA Recycleforce), located at
1255 Roosevelt Avenue Indianapolis, Indiana 46202.

The funding would be used to employ and serve an additional 100 adults returning from prison to
Indianapolis. The funding will help provide immediate wage paying jobs, training and workforce
credentials to medium to high-risk returnees.

The initiative is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because it will expand Recycleforces services
to include people coming home to Indianapolis from federal facilities. The funding will also
help reduce crime in Indianapolis and help reduce the burden on the Marion County court and
reentry oversight system.
