Dear Chair Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

I am requesting funding in the amount of \$5,725,200 to the City of Indianapolis for the Market Street Reconstruction project in fiscal year 2025.

The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Indianapolis, located at 200 East Washington Street Indianapolis, Indiana 46204.

The funding would be used for the complete reconstruction of bricked Market Street from Pennsylvania and Delaware Streets in the heart of downtown Indianapolis. The current roadway is over 60 years old and in deteriorating condition. Improvements to the roadway will allow for Americans with Disabilities Act compliance and improve pedestrian accessibility throughout the corridor.

The initiative is a valuable use of taxpayer funds because the additions will help improve public safety access by improving the road condition for vehicles and pedestrians.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by 23 USC; 133.
